

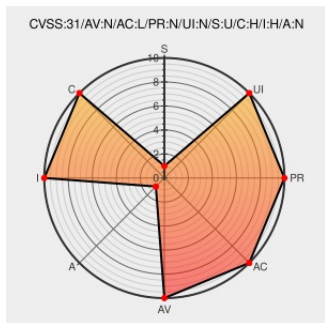

Certain versions of [Smartconrtactgames](#) from [Smartconrtactgames Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue found in DepositGame v.1.0 allows an attacker to gain sensitive information via the GetBonusWithdraw and withdraw functions.

CVE-2020-22647 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
