

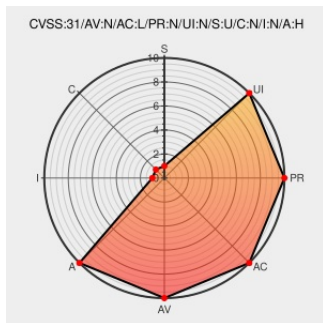

Certain versions of [Jsish](#) from [Jsish](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Stack overflow vulnerability in function `jsi_evalcode_sub` in `jsish` before 3.0.18, allows remote attackers to cause a Denial of Service via a crafted value to the `execute` parameter.

CVE-2020-22907 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
