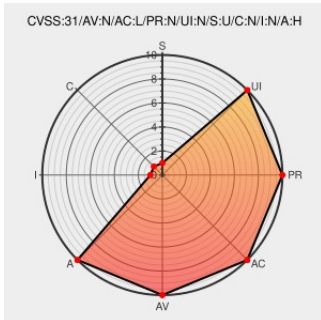

Certain versions of [Jsish](#) from [Jsish](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue found in Jsish v.3.0.11 and before allows an attacker to cause a denial of service via the StringReplaceCmd function in the src/jsiChar.c file.

CVE-2020-23260 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
