

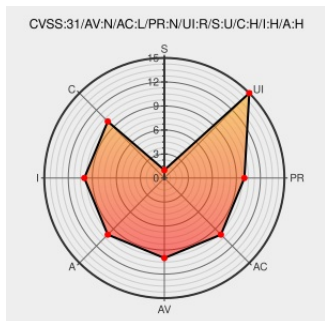

Cross Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability found in Verytops Verydows all versions that allows an attacker to execute arbitrary code via a crafted script.
