

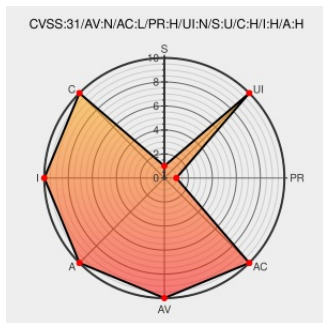

Certain versions of [Imcat](#) from [Txjia](#) contain the following vulnerability: imcat 5.2 allows an authenticated file upload and consequently remote code execution via the picture functionality.
