Certain versions of [188jianzhan](#) from [Vtimecn](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL Injection vulnerability in 188Jianzhan v2.1.0, allows attackers to execute arbitrary code and gain escalated privileges, via the username parameter to login.php.

CVE-2020-23685 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
