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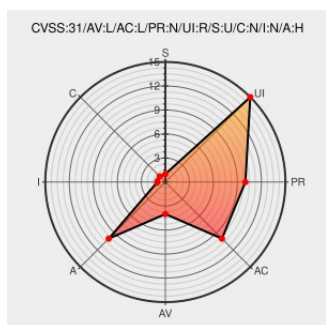

Certain versions of [Asn1c](#) from [Asn1c Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in asn1c through v0.9.28. A NULL pointer dereference exists in the function `_default_error_logger()` located in `asn1fix.c`. It allows an attacker to cause Denial of Service.

CVE-2020-23911 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
