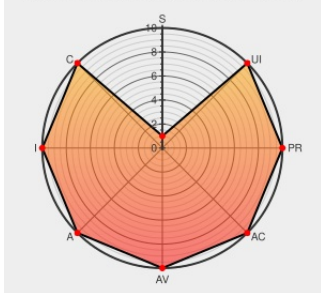

Webexcels Ecommerce CMS 2.x, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 has SQL Injection via the 'content.php' id parameter.

CVE-2020-23976 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
