

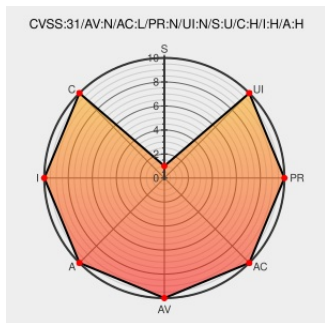

Certain versions of [Conference Management](#) from [Designmasterevents](#) contain the following vulnerability:

DesignMasterEvents Conference management 1.0.0 allows SQL Injection via the username field on the administrator login page.

CVE-2020-23980 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
