

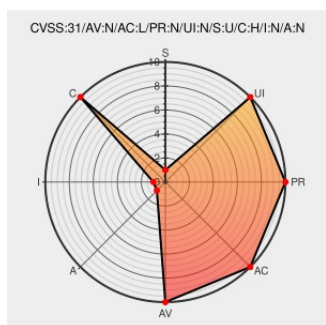

Certain versions of [Playground Sessions](#) from [Playgroundsessions](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Playground Sessions v2.5.582 (and earlier) for Windows, stores the user credentials in plain text allowing anyone with access to UserProfiles.sol to extract the email and password.

CVE-2020-24227 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
