

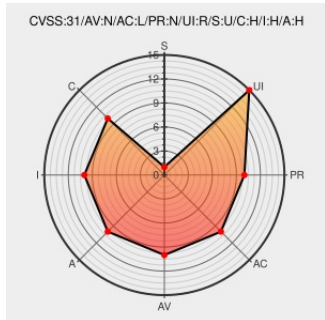

Certain versions of [EasyCMS](#) from [EasyCMS](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A CSRF vulnerability was discovered in EasyCMS v1.6 that can add an admin account through index.php?

s=/admin/rbacuser/insert/navTabId/rbacuser/callbackType/closeCurrent, then post username=***&password=***.

CVE-2020-24271 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
