

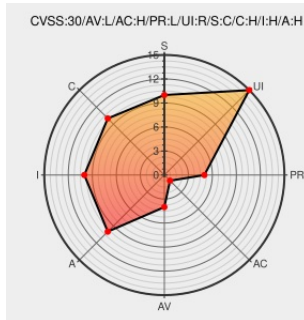

Certain versions of [Solaris](#) from [Oracle](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in the Oracle Solaris product of Oracle Systems (component: Consolidation Infrastructure). The supported version that is affected is 11. Difficult to exploit vulnerability allows low privileged attacker with logon to the infrastructure where Oracle Solaris executes to compromise Oracle Solaris. Successful attacks require human

interaction from a person other than the attacker and while the vulnerability is in Oracle Solaris, attacks may significantly impact additional products. Successful attacks of this vulnerability can result in takeover of Oracle Solaris. CVSS 3.0 Base Score 7.5 (Confidentiality, Integrity and Availability impacts). CVSS Vector: (CVSS:3.0/AV:L/AC:H/PR:L/UI:R/S:C/C:H/I:H/A:H).

CVE-2020-2565 has been assigned by secalert_us@oracle.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
