

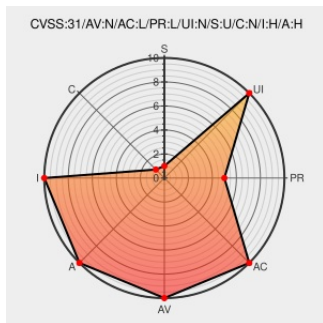

Certain versions of [Monocms](#) from [Monocms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

MonoCMS Blog 1.0 is affected by: Arbitrary File Deletion. Any authenticated user can delete files on and off the webserver (php files can be unlinked and not deleted).

CVE-2020-25985 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
