

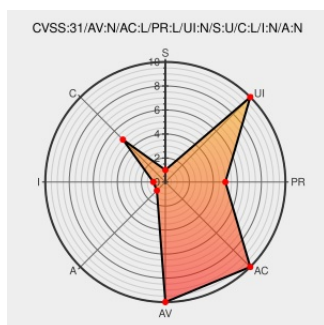

Certain versions of [Telepresence Collaboration Endpoint](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in the video endpoint API (xAPI) of Cisco TelePresence Collaboration Endpoint (CE) Software could allow an authenticated, remote attacker to gain access to sensitive information on an affected device. The vulnerability is due to improper storage of sensitive information on an affected device. An attacker could exploit this

vulnerability by accessing information that should not be accessible to users with low privileges. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to gain access to sensitive information.

CVE-2020-26086 has been assigned by [psirt@cisco.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
