

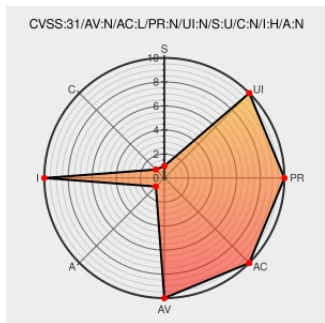

Certain versions of [Cpanel](#) from [Cpanel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

cPanel before 88.0.3 allows attackers to bypass the SMTP greylisting protection mechanism (SEC-491).
