

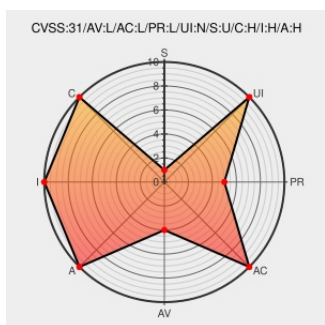

Certain versions of [Dual Dhcp Dns Server](#) from [Dual Dhcp Dns Server Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Dual DHCP DNS Server 7.40. Due to insufficient access restrictions in the default installation directory, an attacker can elevate privileges by replacing the DualServer.exe binary.

CVE-2020-26133 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
