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Certain versions of [Py-xml](#) from [Py-xml Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

py-xml v1.0 was discovered to contain an XML External Entity Injection (XXE) vulnerability which allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted XML file.

CVE-2020-26709 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
