

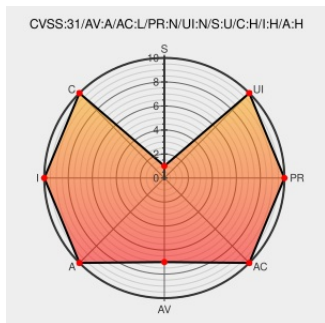

Dr Trust USA iCheck Connect BP Monitor BP Testing 118 1.2.1 is vulnerable to Plain text command over BLE.

CVE-2020-27373 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
