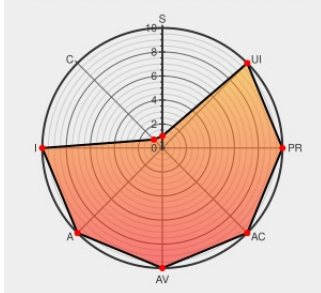

Directory Traversal vulnerability in delete function in admin.api.TemplateController in ZrLog version 2.1.15, allows remote attackers to delete arbitrary files and cause a denial of service (DoS).
