

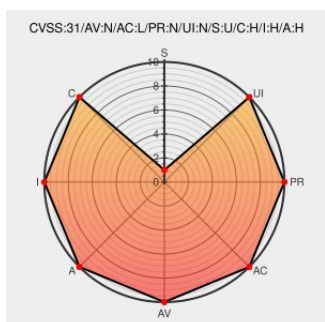

Certain versions of [Library Management System](#) from [Library Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SourceCodester Library Management System 1.0 is affected by SQL Injection allowing an attacker to bypass the user authentication and impersonate any user on the system.

CVE-2020-28073 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
