

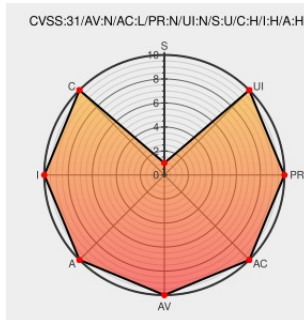

Certain versions of [Online Library Management System](#) from [Online Library Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An Arbitrary File Upload in the Upload Image component in SourceCodester Online Library Management System 1.0 allows the user to conduct remote code execution via admin/borrower/index.php?view=add because .php files can be uploaded to admin/borrower/photos (under the web root).

CVE-2020-28130 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
