

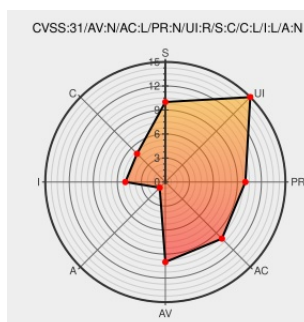

Certain versions of [Sentrifugo](#) from [Saplica](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** UNSUPPORTED WHEN ASSIGNED **** Sentrifugo 3.2 allows Stored Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability by inserting a payload within the X-Forwarded-For HTTP header during the login process. When an administrator looks at logs, the payload is executed. NOTE: This vulnerability only affects products that are no longer supported by the

maintainer.

CVE-2020-28365 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
