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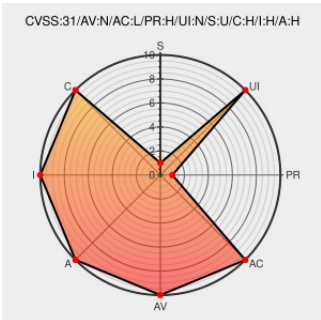

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Certain versions of [Gila Cms](#) from [Gilacms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Gila CMS 1.16.0, an attacker can upload a shell to tmp directy and abuse .htaccess through the logs function for executing PHP files.

CVE-2020-28692 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
