

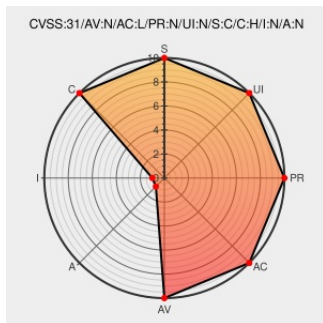

Certain versions of [Fluig](#) from [Totvs](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The TOTVS Fluig platform allows path traversal through the parameter "file = ../" encoded in base64. This affects all versions Fluig Lake 1.7.0, Fluig 1.6.5 and Fluig 1.6.4

CVE-2020-29134 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
