Certain versions of [Online News Portal](#) from [Online News Portal Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Online News Portal using PHP/MySQLi 1.0 is affected by cross-site scripting (XSS) which allows remote attackers to inject an arbitrary web script or HTML via the "Title" parameter.

CVE-2020-29241 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
