

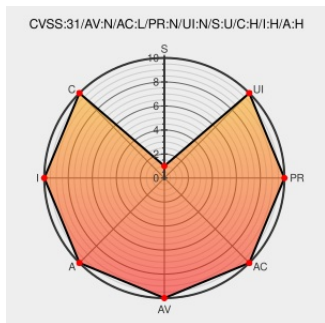

Certain versions of [Bloodx](#) from [Bloodx Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in BloodX 1.0 allows attackers to bypass authentication.

CVE-2020-29282 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
