

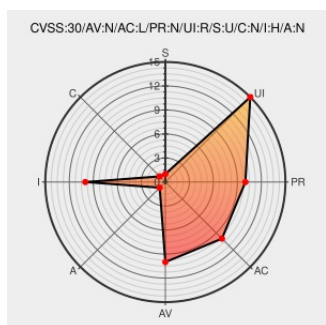

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CVE-2020-3135 - advisory for cisco-sa-ucm-csrf-NbhZTxL

Certain versions of [Unified Communications Manager](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in the web-based management interface of Cisco Unified Communications Manager (UCM) could allow an unauthenticated, remote attacker to conduct a cross-site request forgery (CSRF) attack on an affected device. The vulnerability is due to insufficient CSRF protections for the web-based management interface on an affected

device. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by persuading a user of the interface to follow a malicious link. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to perform arbitrary actions with the privilege level of the targeted user.

CVE-2020-3135 has been assigned by [Cisco](#) psirt@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
