

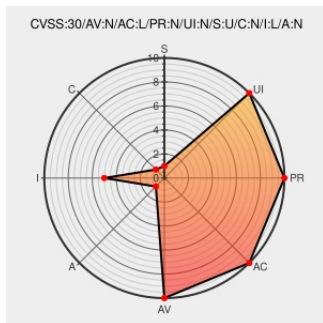

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CVE-2020-3307 - advisory for cisco-sa-alf0-tHwFDmTE

Certain versions of [Firepower Management Center](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in the web UI of Cisco Firepower Management Center (FMC) Software could allow an unauthenticated, remote attacker to write arbitrary entries to the log file on an affected device. The vulnerability is due to insufficient input validation. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by sending a crafted HTTP request to an

affected device. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to send incorrect information to the system log on the affected system.

CVE-2020-3307 has been assigned by [Cisco](#) psirt@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
