

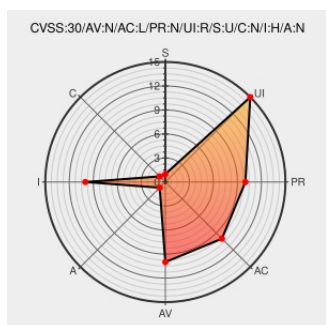

CVE-2020-3440 - advisory for cisco-sa-webex-desktop-app-OVSfpVMj

Certain versions of [Webex Meetings](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in Cisco Webex Meetings Desktop App for Windows could allow an unauthenticated, remote attacker to overwrite arbitrary files on an end-user system. The vulnerability is due to improper validation of URL parameters that are sent from a website to the affected application. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by

persuading a user to follow a URL to a website that is designed to submit crafted input to the affected application. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to overwrite arbitrary files on the affected system, possibly corrupting or deleting critical system files.

CVE-2020-3440 has been assigned by [Cisco](#) psirt@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
