

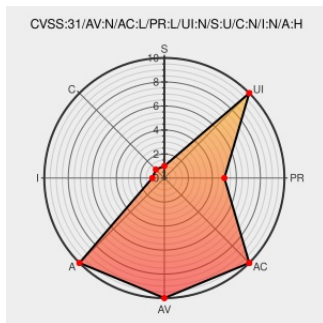

Certain versions of [Atomix](#) from [Atomix](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in Atomix v3.1.5 allows attackers to cause a denial of service (DoS) via a Raft session flooding attack using Raft OpenSessionRequest messages.

CVE-2020-35210 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
