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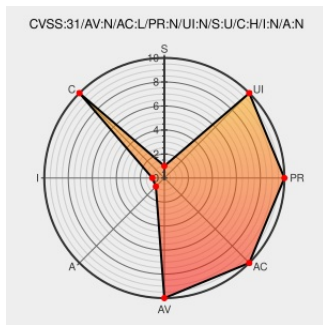

Certain versions of [Expertpdf](#) from [Expertpdf](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A local file inclusion vulnerability in ExpertPDF 9.5.0 through 14.1.0 allows attackers to read the file contents from files that the running ExpertPDF process has access to read.

CVE-2020-35340 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
