Certain versions of [Klog Server](#) from [Klogserver](#) contain the following vulnerability:

KLog Server 2.4.1 allows OS command injection via shell metacharacters in the actions/authenticate.php user parameter.

CVE-2020-35729 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
