

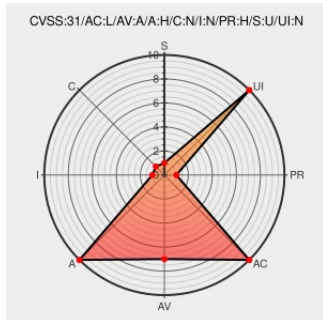

Certain versions of **R7800** from **Netgear** contain the following vulnerability:

NETGEAR R7800 devices before 1.0.2.74 are affected by a buffer overflow by an authenticated user.
