

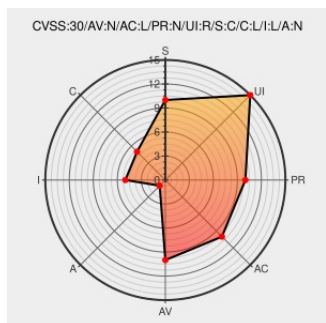

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CVE-2020-3579 - advisory for cisco-sa-vmxss2-NL4KSSVR

Certain versions of [Catalyst Sd-wan Manager](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in the web-based management interface of Cisco SD-WAN vManage Software could allow an unauthenticated, remote attacker to conduct a cross-site scripting (XSS) attack against a user of the interface. The vulnerability exists because the web-based management interface does not properly validate user-supplied input.

An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by persuading a user to click a crafted link. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to execute arbitrary script code in the context of the interface or access sensitive, browser-based information.

CVE-2020-3579 has been assigned by [Cisco](#) psirt@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
