

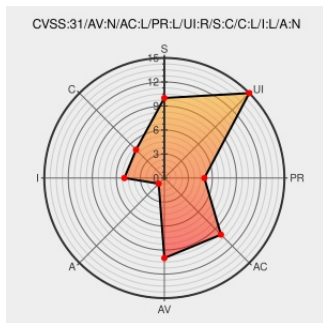

Certain versions of [Yzmcms](#) from [Yzmcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A storage XSS vulnerability is found in YzmCMS v5.8, which can be used by attackers to inject JS code and attack malicious XSS on the `/admin/system_manage/user_config_edit.html` page.

CVE-2020-35971 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
