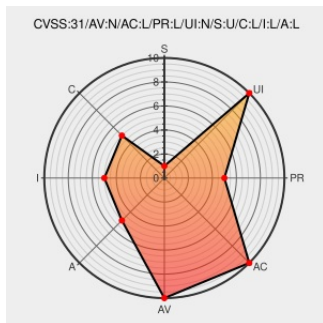

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Certain versions of **Node Whois** from **Furqansoftware** contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability classified as critical has been found in Furqan node-whois. Affected is an unknown function of the file index.coffee. The manipulation leads to improperly controlled modification of object prototype attributes ('prototype pollution'). It is possible to launch the attack remotely. The name of the patch is

46ccc2aee8d063c7b6b4dee2c2834113b7286076. It is recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-216252.

CVE-2020-36618 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
