Certain versions of [Axmlrpc](#) from [Axmlrpc Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability classified as problematic was found in gturri aXMLRPC up to 1.12.0. This vulnerability affects the function ResponseParser of the file src/main/java/de/timroes/axmlrpc/ResponseParser.java. The manipulation leads to xml external entity reference. Upgrading to version 1.12.1 is able to address this issue. The patch is identified as

ad6615b3ec41353e614f6ea5fdd5b046442a832b. It is recommended to upgrade the affected component. VDB-217450 is the identifier assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2020-36641 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
