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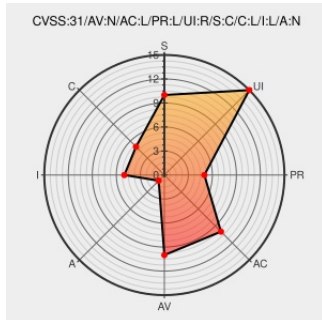

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Certain versions of [Website Builder](#) from [Elementor](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Elementor Website Builder plugin for WordPress is vulnerable to Stored Cross-Site Scripting via SVG image uploads in versions up to, and including 2.9.7 This makes it possible for authenticated attackers with the upload_files capability to inject arbitrary web scripts in pages that will execute whenever a user accesses the page with the stored

web scripts.

CVE-2020-36703 has been assigned by security@wordfence.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
