

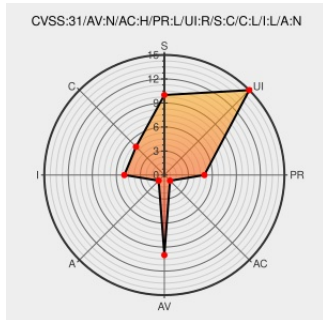

Certain versions of [Prestashop](#) from [Prestashop](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In PrestaShop before version 1.7.6.5, there is a reflected XSS while running the security compromised page. It allows anyone to execute arbitrary action. The problem is patched in the 1.7.6.5.

CVE-2020-5264 has been assigned by security-advisories@github.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
