Certain versions of [Calendar01](#) from [Calendar01 Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in [Calendar01] free edition ver1.0.0 and [Calendar02] free edition ver1.0.0 allows remote attackers to hijack the authentication of administrators via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2020-5615 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
