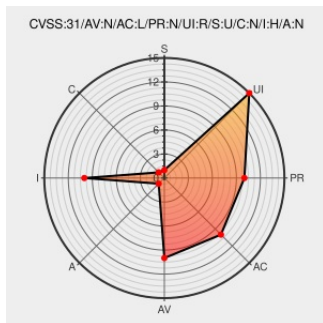

Certain versions of **Nagios Xi** from **Nagios** contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site request forgery in Nagios XI 5.7.3 allows a remote attacker to perform sensitive application actions by tricking legitimate users into clicking a crafted link.

CVE-2020-5790 has been assigned by vulnreport@tenable.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
