Certain versions of [Big-ip Application Security Manager](#) from [F5](#) contain the following vulnerability:

On BIG-IP ASM 11.6.1-11.6.5.1, under certain configurations, the BIG-IP system sends data plane traffic to back-end servers unencrypted, even when a Server SSL profile is applied.

CVE-2020-5879 has been assigned by f5sirt@f5.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
