Certain versions of [Imagegear](#) from [Accusoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An exploitable out-of-bounds write vulnerability exists in the bmp_parsing function of the igcore19d.dll library of Accusoft ImageGear, version 19.5.0. A specially crafted BMP file can cause an out-of-bounds write, resulting in a remote code execution. An attacker needs to provide a malformed file to the victim to trigger the

vulnerability.

CVE-2020-6065 has been assigned by [talos-cna@cisco.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
