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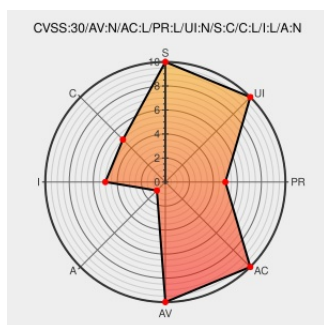

Certain versions of [Opensis](#) from [Os4ed](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerabilities exist in the course\_period\_id parameters used in OS4Ed openSIS 7.3 pages. The course\_period\_id parameter in the page MassDropSessionSet.php is vulnerable to SQL injection. An attacker can make an authenticated HTTP request to trigger these vulnerabilities.

CVE-2020-6130 has been assigned by [Cisco Talos](#) talos-cna@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
