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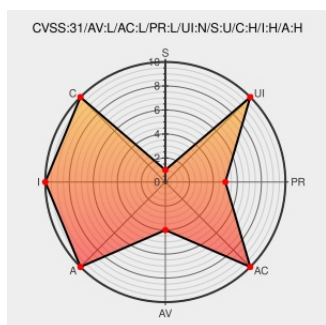

Certain versions of **Mac Os X** from **Apple** contain the following vulnerability:

Inappropriate implementation in installer in Google Chrome on OS X prior to 83.0.4103.61 allowed a local attacker to perform privilege escalation via a crafted file.

CVE-2020-6477 has been assigned by chrome-cve-admin@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
