

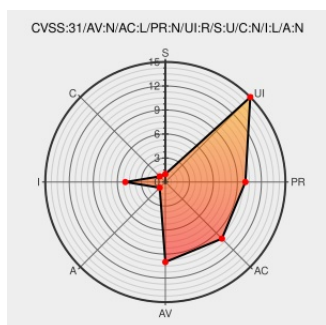

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Insufficient policy enforcement in downloads in Google Chrome prior to 83.0.4103.61 allowed a remote attacker to bypass navigation restrictions via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2020-6488 has been assigned by [chrome-cve-admin@google.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
