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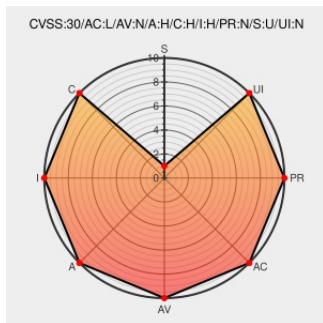

Certain versions of **Pixelstor 5000** from **Rasili** contain the following vulnerability:

languageOptions.php in Rasili PixelStor 5000 K:4.0.1580-20150629 (KDI Version) allows unauthenticated attackers to remotely execute code via the lang parameter.

CVE-2020-6756 has been assigned by [M cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
