

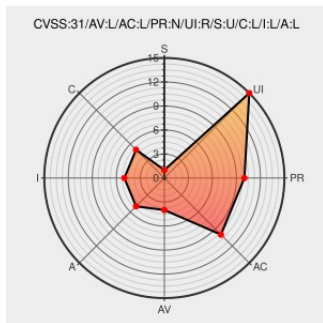

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CVE-2020-7374 - advisory for

Certain versions of [Free Pdf Editor](#) from [Documalis](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Documalis Free PDF Editor version 5.7.2.26 and Documalis Free PDF Scanner version 5.7.2.122 do not appropriately validate the contents of JPEG images contained within a PDF. Attackers can exploit this vulnerability to trigger a buffer overflow on the stack and gain remote code execution as the user running the Documalis Free PDF Editor or

Documalis Free PDF Scanner software.

CVE-2020-7374 has been assigned by [cve@rapid7.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
