Certain versions of [Gulp-tape](#) from [Gulp-tape Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

gulp-tape through 1.0.0 allows execution of arbitrary commands. It is possible to inject arbitrary commands as part of 'gulp-tape' options.

CVE-2020-7605 has been assigned by report@snyk.io to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
