



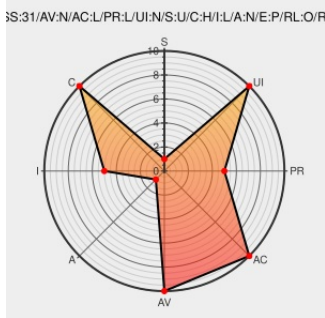

Certain versions of [Phpspreadsheet](#) from [Phpspreadsheet Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:



This affects the package phppoffice/phpspreadsheet from 0.0.0. The library is vulnerable to XSS when creating an html output from an excel file by adding a comment on any cell. The root cause of this issue is within the HTML writer where user comments are concatenated as part of link and this is returned as HTML. A fix for this issue is available on [commit 0ed5b800be2136bcb8fa9c1bdf59abc957a98845/master branch](#).

CVE-2020-7776 has been assigned by 🦉 report@snyk.io to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
